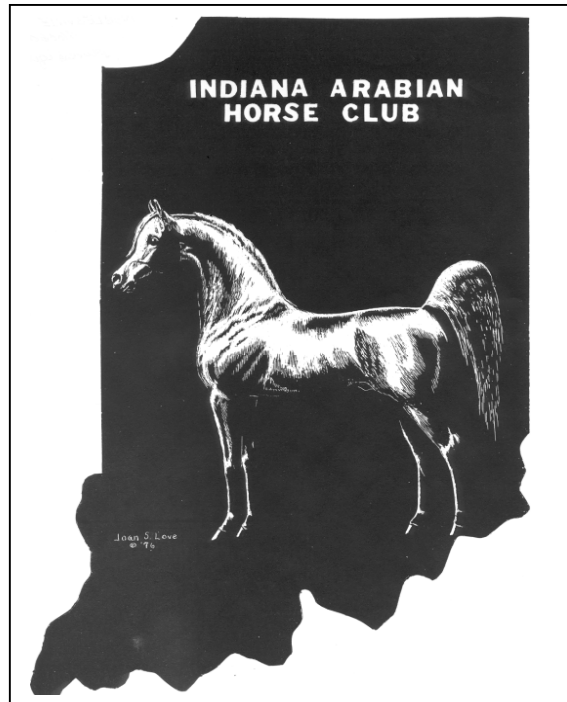

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ADMISSION TO ARENA No person will be permitted to enter the arena except class participants, judges and their assistants, show photographers and show management personnel. Attendants will not be permitted in arena until summoned by order of the judge

2. AGE OF INDIVIDUALS The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1 will assume the greater age on that date.

3. AMATEUR STATUS Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification, which must be renewed annually, will expire on November 30 and must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Forms may be obtained from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. This annual USEF Amateur fee is \$30.00 see the entry blank.

4. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIMES: Stalls are available from noon, Thursday, April 16 2009, until 10 a.m., Monday, April 20, 2009. Early arrivals or late departures **MUST** contact the Crossroads: Facility Phone #765-795-4768 or Steve Jackson cell: 765-720-3251

5. ASTM HEADGEAR Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitting.

6. BARN OFFICE. The barn office will be in the south end of the Expo Center building. Between the concession stand and the show office. Stall assignments should be picked up at the Barn Office, not at the Show Office.

7. BICYCLES, MOTORBIKES, CHILD SCOOTER BOARDS and ROLLERBLADES are prohibited. (See Minors) This rule will be **ENFORCED**.

8. CALL FOR CLASSES The **two minute** rule will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**. If time is needed for a tack change, the gate must be notified in advance. All tack changes must be made at the entrance gate to the arena. This rule will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED!!**

9. CAMPERS All house trailers, campers, motor homes, tents, etc., must be parked at all times at the Campgrounds area on the east side of the building. Hook up fee is \$20.00 per unit, per night collected by Crossroads personnel. Parking next to the building is reserved for passenger vehicles (cars/trucks).

10. CHARGE CARDS ACCEPTED See the entry blank.



11. CONCESSION RESTRICTIONS The Crossroads Arena and Expos Center has contracted with an exclusive concession contractor to handle all food and drink concessions.

12 CONDUCT Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges/Officials on the part of the owner, trainer, rider or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited. The Show Committee also bears the responsibility to aid the judges in avoiding contact with exhibitors or their agents before and during the show.

13. CROSS ENTRIES Cross entries are prohibited between the Country English Pleasure sections and the English Pleasure sections at the same show

14. CROSSROADS ARENA & EXPO CENTER LOCATION. **Directions To Crossroads Arena & Expo Center: Between Indianapolis and Terre Haute South of I-70:** Going East or West on I-70 Exit on Exit 41 (Cloverdale exit). Go south on Highway 231 and after the I-70 underpass it's the 3rd stoplight, Stardust Road. Turn West and go about 1 mile to location on the right. **Visit their website: www.crossroadsarena.net**

15. DIVISION OF CLASSES Rail classes will be split as follows Saddle - 26; Driving - 12; Native Costume - 21. Management reserves the right to split any class for safety purposes.

16. DOGS All dogs must be leashed and tied in stall area, not in aisles.

17. ENTRIES Entries will close Monday, March 30, 2009. Those received by this date will be acknowledged. Entries **postmarked** after this date, or received after April 3, 2009, will be charged post entry fees. Entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form for the show. The entry form may be duplicated. Farm names will be used only if the stable or farm is the owner appearing on the horse's registration papers, or if the stable or farm has been registered with USEF and the number shown on the USEF Farm Registration Certificate is noted on the entry form. A copy of your USEF Farm Registration Certificate should accompany your entry. A photocopy of both sides of the Certificate of Registration of each horse entered must be submitted with the entry forms. If the name shown on the registration papers is different from the person entering the horse, an affidavit, a copy of the sales contract or authorization form must be filed with the Show Office. Any corporation owning and showing a horse must be a member of AHA and that membership number must be on the entry form.

18. FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a Federation-Licensed Competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc.(the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of the Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

19. USEF MEMBERSHIP: Life, senior active, and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

20. FOOTING The arena measures 120' x 570' divided into the paddock, work ring and show ring. These areas have dirt footing.

21. HEALTH PAPERS AND COGGINS All out-of-state horses must have a negative Coggins test within twelve (12) months and a current (30 day) health certificate.

22. JUDGES In the event due to illness or failure of a Judge to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge.

23. JUDGING SYSTEM All Purebred Arabian and HA/AA In-Hand and Breeding classes will be judged using the AHA approved Scoring System and Ring Procedures. The Breeding and In-Hand classes will use the In-Ring Procedure. All Sport Horse In-Hand classes will be judged using the AHA approved Sport Horse Judging System.

24. MANURE DISPOSAL Manure disposal is provided for in designated areas.

25. MEMBERSHIPS Memberships are required of all exhibitors in AHA and USEF. See the Entry Blank for details. AHA Single Event Memberships at \$30.00 are available; USEF Non-Memberships are available for \$30.00.

26. MINORS: *Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.*

27. PARKING The Crossroads Arena and Expo Center has spaces for 1000 vehicles to park. There is no fee for parking.

28. P.A. SYSTEM Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the P.A. System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible for having his horse at the gate at the prescribed time.

29. POST ENTRIES Post entries are accepted and will be charged an additional fee of \$10.00 for each class entered after the closing date of March 30. The session-by-session deadlines for post entries made at the show will be strictly adhered to.

30. PROTESTS Protests may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred; accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 if made by an USEF Member or \$300 if made by a Non-Member; (if check, payable to the competition). It must be received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager of the competition or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. Article 602.d

31. REFUNDS All Refunds on fees will be made upon request with a written statement from your veterinarian on said veterinarian's letterhead, if received by March 30, 2009. **NO REFUNDS** on stalls after March 30, 2009. Office Charge will be deducted. Refunds will be mailed. Exhibitors must notify the Show Secretary of cancellations prior to the time the class is called. If you do not scratch there is a \$10.00 fee that will be added to your account.

32. REGIONAL QUALIFICATION To qualify for a Regional Championship Class, a horse must have received the required points in that section/class entered in an AHA Recognized show that was recognized by AHA for that Region within the preceding calendar year and that period of the current year prior to the commencement of the show in which the Regional Championship is held.

33. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., (or in the case of a foreign entry, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Registry of America), and/or the Canadian Horse Registry, or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for (Exception: AR 236.1) and must be entered in their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. A copy of the registration papers will be returned when exhibitors pick up their numbers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age that are eligible for registry and registration applied for).

Horses shown in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a Certificate of Registration from AHA in the Half-Arabian Registry or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have a CPAR permit. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and applied for registration. (Only weanlings who have applied for registration may show without papers.) The horse must be entered under its full registered name. Half-Arabian colts/stallions two years and older may not compete in Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian in hand classes. (Refer to USEF rules) committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the Show.

34. RESPONSIBILITY The Indiana Arabian Horse club, Inc., accepts no responsibility for loss or destruction of property or equipment not owned by them or for damages to or by animals on exhibition at this show grounds or stabling areas. Show management will have the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA rules. The Indiana Arabian Horse Club Inc., recommends all exhibitors become members of USEF. Special emphasis will be placed on rules pertaining to retention of natural action. Leg chains, rattlers, or other artificial appliances on a horse's leg while on the show grounds will be cause for immediate removal for the show and all winnings forfeited. To make the show enjoyable for all concerned, exhibitors are encouraged to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, adhering to all rules and regulations. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Intoxication, disrespect of the Judge and/or Show committee will be liable to disqualification for events and cancellation of awards without claims for damages.

35. RETURNED CHECKS There will be a **\$50.00** fee for returned checks.

36. SECURITY In the event you should have an emergency call 911.

37. SHOEING REGULATIONS See the current USEF Rule Book for shoeing requirements on Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses.

38. SHOW OFFICE. The Indiana All Arabian Show Office will be located in the south west end of the Crossroads Arena and Expos Center and personnel will be on duty in the office according to posted times during the three days of the show and move in day.

39. SHOW OFFICE HOURS Any variations in the following schedule will be announced and posted on the show office door. Exhibitors are requested to report to the show office as soon as possible after arrival, to pick up show packets, correct any pending items or make entries.

Post entries accepted one session ahead of the class.

Show office will remain open during lunch/dinner breaks, but will close for lunch and dinner once the afternoon/evening sessions begin.

40. SMOKING RESTRICTIONS By the order of the State Fire Marshall, smoking is prohibited in the barns. All exhibitors expressly agree to be responsible for any levied fines when signing the entry form.

41. STALLS There are 500 stalls available. Please pick up stall assignments from the BARN OFFICE located in the south end of the Crossroads Arena and Expo Center. Stall assignments will be made in the order paid entries and requests are received. Exhibitors wishing to be stalled with other exhibitors must submit entries together. All horses must be stabled. Absolutely no showing from trailers will be permitted

Stabling is provided with semi-portable stalls "Preifert Brand" with solid sides and bars. Stalls have sliding doors and are located under the same roof as the show and work arenas. All stalls are indoors. Tapes, stickers, nails, tacks, staples, hooks, screws, permanent markings (such as paint and ink), and other objects, shall not be inserted or placed on or into facility walls, doors, floors, ceilings, trees or posts Exhibitors will be responsible for cost of repairing any damage or alterations to stalls. No wheelbarrows will be available on grounds.

42. TRAILER PARKING All horse vans may unload on each side of the Crossroads Arena and Expo Center. After unloading they will park in designated area.

43. VETERINARIAN INSPECTION At the Show Committee's discretion, all animals are subject to a physical inspection, free of charge, by show veterinarian as a safeguard against communicable equine disease.

44. WHIPS If whips are allowed, they must be no longer than 6' including the snapper or lash. Exception: Harness classes.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS FOR CLASSES NOT LISTED IN THE USEF RULE BOOK

For a Medal to be awarded, three (3) competitors with proper appointments must compete.
Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st.

AHA Reining Seat Medal, JTR: All contestants are required to perform a reining pattern as outlined in USEF reining or EC equivalent. AHA Score sheet shall be used. Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bit. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.

AHA Horsemanship Medal JTR: All contestants are required to perform rail work and a pattern composed of a minimum of four tests from USEF AR 215

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal, JTR: Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

AHA Saddle Seat Medal, JTR: Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used.

Green Horse Classes: Open to any age horse that was not shown in performance prior to December 1, of the previous year. No cross entry allowed for horse between green horse class and any class that requires a canter or lope. Walk and trot/jog only gaits to be used.

Schooling Classes: These schooling classes are not judged. Training tack and attire is optional. Appropriate gaits will be called for each class.

Liberty Class: Limited to maximum of 10 entries, A/HA/AA horse to be at least 2 years old. Exhibitor to provide required music for performance in acceptable format. Horses will be judged on style, grace, animation, gaits, presence, music and suitability and ease of catching. Judging begins when the halter is removed by the exhibitor. Time of Liberty shall be 2 minutes; time to catch shall be 1 ½ minutes or horse will be disqualified. Whips and shaker bottles allowed, but may not touch the horse during performance. Exhibitor may have one helper, but exhibitor with number on their back must remove halter and catch horse. Outside assistance is not permitted. This is a winner take all class of 100% of the entry fees.

Pro-Am Classes: Shown at comparable gaits and attire for the discipline. First direction with professional rider, call to line up, change riders and show second direction with Amateur rider.

Ride a buck: Dollar bill will be placed under rider's leg by official. Gaits will be called when rider loses dollar they must go to center ring. Last person remaining with dollar wins.

Boot Race: Each rider will remove one boot to be put at opposite end of arena. Riders, when told will ride to boot, put it on and ride back. First one back wins.

Sack Race: Each rider has a partner at the opposite end of arena with a sack. Riders ride to partner put one foot in sack and race back to start line. First one back wins.
